Findings, Issues, and Opportunities and Challenges that Need to Be Addressed

- Several stakeholders emphasized that more debt is not the answer for many small businesses. Everyone is looking forward to the new \$500 million Small Business Grant Program.
- Need to include the UC Santa Cruz and Stanford study on the impact of the pandemic on businesses of color. <u>The</u> <u>Impact of Covid-19 on Small Business Owners: Evidence of Early-Stage Losses from the April 2020 Current Population</u> <u>Survey</u> and <u>this paper which includes data through June 2020</u>.
- Need to review the new studies on PPP and track findings.
- Re-assign underutilized small business funding to meet current small business needs.

Recommendations to Support Access to Capital

- Tristan, Little Hoover Commission. This is one of several reports from LHC relating to the pandemic. *First Steps Toward Recovery: Saving Small Businesses*, Little Hoover Commission: <u>https://lhc.ca.gov/report/first-steps-toward-recovery-saving-small-businesses</u>
 - Increased funding from state to CA Rebuilding Fund
 - o Increase funding from private equity to Rebuilding Fund
 - Increase ability for CDFIs to lend
- Eugene Cornelius, Milken Institute, discussed their recommendation on mapping the financial ecosystem. There is currently no single place to find information on available capital and technical assistance. The state needs a comprehensive and current source of this information.  - Mapping all sources of capital for small businesses (i.e. grants, private equity, loans) on state, county and city level
 - Need partnerships for lending to underserved markets

- Susan Lovenburg, California Forward, is working on its post-Economic Summit Roadmap to Shared Prosperity, which should be available in January 2021. The Roadmap is intended to serve as a plan for collective action.  - David Nelson, CalAsian, is sending a link to their joint paper with other ethnic chambers on small business access to capital. This was a preparatory paper to the Small Business Advocate-led work group.
 - There is a need to expand and further fund TA to support A2C
- Manie Grewal, RDEF, asked whether the capital programs were including social enterprises and, if not, that nonprofits and social enterprises should be included.

- CAMEO, Small Business Majority, and others made these recommendations based on their member's experience:
 - o Reauthorize PPP with greater program flexibility and targeting to underserved business owners.
 - Small Businesses need cash assistance, especially those that have been shut down due to COVID-19 pandemic Orders for five to eight months.
 - Streamline Treasury small business programs
 - o Create, expand, or remove impediments to small businesses accessing lines of credit.
 - o Extend the SBA 7(a) loan deferrals. The deferral authority has sunset.
 - Reactivate the State Small Business Capital Initiative (SSBCI), which is a federal program established during the Great Recession.
 - Recapture SSBCI funds and assign to cover fees under the California Small Business Loan Guarantee Program.
 Federal disaster programs do not charge a loan guarantee fee.
 - o Establish a state CDFI Fund for mission-driven lenders.
 - Create a state public bank.
 - o Implement small business lending disclosure requirements
 - "Confessions of Judgement" (federal)

- Support CFPB 1071 (federal), which will provide key information on small business lending
